We decided to partner with Breaking the Silence because their vision is to end the stigma, shame, silence and secrecy surrounding mental illness and suicide. Ryan helped many of his friends who were struggling; he became a sounding board, taking on their problems and providing them with comfort and guidance. We want to continue his work and help fund more education to this ever increasing population.
